Goods being offered for sale may not necessarily be awarded for sale after the subsequent analysis of bids. The Seller reserves its right to withdraw any of the above-mentioned lots from the scope of tender.
4. The physical transfer of the Goods shall be made on “as-is-where is” basis and the Seller shall not be responsible vis-à-vis the Buyer for warranties and guarantees for workmanship which may normally be applied to the sales of goods under applicable laws. For this reason, it is strongly recommended that prospective bidders or their agents inspect the goods to confirm qualities? and

condition of the goods prior to submitting their bids.

5. Payment for goods awarded shall be transferred to the account of the Seller as stated on the invoice within 14 days of the issue date of the official invoice.
6. The Seller shall not release goods to the Buyer until payment is made in full along with the signed transfer of goods (see appendix 3) and funds have been fully received by the Seller.
